This hike should run the full 3 hours and cover over 4 miles in distance. **ACTIVITY LEVEL:** Moderate. **WHERE TO MEET:** The High Rock Road parking area. There will be an L.L.Bean sign marking the entrance. **WHAT TO BRING:** Please dress appropriately for the weather conditions (layers, no cotton). Wear appropriate footwear for hiking. Please bring water, snacks and any personal medicines and gear you may need as well. **OPTIONAL ITEMS:** Camera, binoculars. Up to 20 flotillas with six ships, lead by a foreign flag ship, are expected to take part. Boston is hosting the Parade of Sail for the first time in 17 years. The event, which is expected to draw a large crowd, is set to start June 17. The Sail Boston Festival and the public boarding of ships will take place between Saturday, June 17 and Wednesday, June 21. Fireworks are scheduled for June 17 and June 21. 
