



Daniels to lead NCOA in 1989

Al Daniels, owner of Normandy Farms Family Campground, Foxboro, MA, was unanimously re-elected to a second, one-year term as the National President of NCOA. Daniels was re-elected by the Board of Directors at their meeting on November 5th. He has served since November, 1987, and will serve until the 1989 NCOA convention.

The Board also elected a slate of officers to serve on the association's Executive Committee along with Daniels. Bob Greene, Greene Acres Campground, Williamston, NC, was elected First Vice President, stepping up from the 2nd VP slot. Erv Banes, NCOA Treasurer since 1986, moved up to 2nd Vice President. Banes is the owner of the Frankenmuth RV Park, Frankenmuth, MI. Herb Strauss, Papoose Pond Resort, North Waterford, Maine, was elected Treasurer, and Rita Ganser, General Manager of Towerpoint Resort, Mesa, Arizona, will serve another term as secretary.

Greene and Strauss also serve as Presidents of their respective state campground associations.

In accepting the Presidency for a second year, Daniels said, "NCOA has made great progress during 1988,

and I'm looking forward to even greater achievements in the next year. I'm very proud to serve the industry and hope that I can give back to the industry at least a small part of what I've gained by serving."
