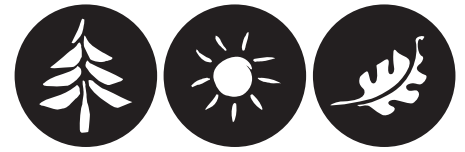

An attendant at the Hospitality Station can be reached at [866-673-2767](tel:866-673-2767) x312 for non-medical emergencies. If they have temporarily left the building, please leave a detailed message with your name and site number so that we're able to accommodate your needs.

Camping Etiquette

Whether you're a seasoned veteran or a first-time camper, these basic tips will help to ensure that everyone enjoys their camping experience.

- Shhh . . . Quiet hours are 11pm–8am.
- Prevent Forest Fires! Campfires are permitted in fire rings during seasonal hours and should always be attended and properly extinguished.
- Help us keep critters away by depositing all trash and recycling in the appropriate dumpsters.
- Help preserve our grass by keeping tents off grassy areas.
- Please respect your neighbors and other campers and use walkways, rather than cutting through sites.
- SLOW DOWN, for kids sake! Please observe our 9 mph speed limit throughout the park.
- All campground buildings are smoke free.

Things You Should Know

- There is a limit of 10 visitors to a campsite/day.
- To ensure a peaceful environment and prevent overcrowding, sharing sites is not permitted.
- Our water pressure is 80-100 lbs! We recommend the use of a pressure regulator, which is available in our General Store.
- For water conservation, we are unable to permit campers to wash RV's or any vehicles at their sites. Please inquire at the Reception Center for other options.
- State law: No sink/shower waste shall be discarded on the ground.
- Remote antennas, except DSS satellite antennas, are prohibited. Only those designed for camping units are permissible.
- Please, no clotheslines attached to trees. Accessory clothesline racks should be attached to the bumper of the camping unit.
- Nothing is to be hung, nailed, or tied to any trees. Any ornaments, flags, signs, etc. must be attached to the camping unit. Any ornamental lights must be hung on the RV, not on trees.
- Only one small discretely located, refrigerator less than 5 cubic feet permitted outside camper.
- Please no gas bottles in excess of 40 lbs.
- Generators are not permitted in the Outback sites.
- Requested sites are subject to change without notice.
- It is always a good idea to secure any valuable items, such as bicycles or coolers, before retiring for the evening.
- We reserve the right to deny campsites to persons under the age of 25 in order to maintain the peace and tranquility of the campground.
- Please refrain from disruptive noises between the hours of 11pm-8am. All children must be at their site by 11pm.

Reservation Cancellation Guidelines

- Rental units require two months notice.
- If you have a reservation for a stay of 7 nights or longer during our peak season (mid-June thru August), 1-month notice is required.
- Seasonal Packages-inquire for individual cancellation requirements.
- All other reservations require 2 week's notice prior to the reservation date.
- Each cancelled reservation will result in a \$25 processing fee.
- Sadly, even in cases of an emergency or inclement weather, we cannot refund deposits when a cancellation occurs without proper notice.

Pets

We offer a spacious dog park, called Freedom Tail Park where dogs are free to chase their tails. Please abide by the guidelines posted at the dog park. The following general guidelines are for the health, safety, and peaceful environment of all our guests.

- Owners must clean up after their pets.
- Disruptive noise, especially dog barking, is not welcome.
- Aggressive behavior is not permitted.
- Owner must carry proof of current vaccinations.
- Visitors are unable to bring pets to the park.
- Conveniently located "doggy" stations can be found in the park, equipped with disposal bags to

help ensure that all pets are picked up after.

- Conveniently located "Pooch Posts" to tie up your dog can be found throughout the park.
- Pets must be leashed (except in the dog park) and attended at all times. If you leave your site, please do not leave your pet unattended at the site, in the camping unit or vehicle.
- Pets, except service dogs, are not permitted in rental units (unless designated), at rental sites, campground buildings, swimming pools or pool areas, playgrounds or any other posted location.

Trash & Recycling Dumpsters

Dumpsters are conveniently placed throughout the park and now being green is even easier than ever with dumpsters that combine mixed paper, recyclable glass, aluminum, cans and plastics ALL IN ONE PLACE! Our single sort recycling dumpsters are located at the Garage, near site 1111, and in the parking area across from the Recreation Lodge. Please note, that if you deposit recyclables in a trash bag, it must be clear. See the office for extra bags.

Motorcycles, Golf Carts, ATV's Motorized Scooters, Hover Boards, Mopeds (or any similar vehicle)

We're sorry, these vehicles are not permitted to be operated in the park. They may be escorted in & out of the campground without the motor running. Please note that if you are disabled and require the use of a golf cart, our insurance company requires a certificate of insurance naming Normandy Farms as additional insured.

Expecting Visitors?

Guests may visit for the day or overnight. Those occupying our rental units may only have day guests. All visitors must register and pay at the Reception Center. Day visitors are welcome to arrive between 8am and 9pm, but must check out by 10pm. Overnight visitors must check out by 12pm the following day. Children under the age of 3 and Senior Citizens are admitted free when visiting for the day. There is a charge for Senior Citizens who stay overnight. There is a limit of 10 visitors to a campsite and we reserve the right to limit the number of persons and vehicles occupying and/or visiting a site. Sorry, visitors are unable to bring pets.

Lost & Found

If you have lost an item or found something that doesn't belong to you, the central Lost & Found area is located at the Reception Center. Additional lost & found areas are located at the Recreation Lodge and Pool #2.

Wildlife & Insects

Exposing your family to the joys of camping also means introducing them to wildlife and some undesirable insects. To avoid attracting these critters to your site, you should not leave food or trash out. Please note, Norfolk County sprays for mosquitoes during our summer season.

Gift Cards

Purchase a Normandy Farms Gift Card on our website at normandyfarms.com or at our Reception Center.

Check Out Times

For those guests staying in our rental units, check out time is 11am. Check out for all others is 12pm. Unfortunately during our summer season from mid-June through Labor Day, late stays are not permitted. During the spring and fall, a late checkout is possible if the site is not reserved for the next evening. From noon to 3pm there is no additional fee, after 3pm up to 5pm the fee is \$20.00 and beyond 5pm it would be the regular nightly site fee. Please inquire at the Reception Center on the day of your checkout to see if your site may be available for a late stay.

Campfires

Help prevent forest fires! From Labor Day Weekend through Memorial Day, campfires are permitted from 6am to Midnight. After Memorial Day to Labor Day Weekend, campfires are permitted from 6pm to Midnight. Ability to have fires is determined by local conditions and is subject to change. Only one steel fire ring may be used for campfires. Fires should not exceed one foot above steel ring. Firewood pallets are not permitted. Please extinguish fire completely before retiring or leaving your campsite. Never leave a fire unattended!

Transportation

Boston's Logan Airport is 35 miles from the park and Providence's T.F. Green is just 25 miles. The commuter train traveling to and from Boston is located just 3 miles from Normandy Farms. There is also a subway station located about 20 miles away that offers a more flexible schedule. Veteran's Taxi (508)543-5353.

Wristbands

In order to ensure that all guests are registered, all children (aged 3-17) will be given a wristband to wear during their stay. The wristbands will be distributed from our Hospitality Station when it is staffed, otherwise they will be given out at the Reception Center. These wristbands are required for children to access the pools, bike park and planned recreation events. If you are expecting visitors during your stay, please be advised that visitors between the ages of 3-17 will also be issued wristbands. Please notify us if your occupants have changed since you made your reservation so that we can update the number of wristbands that will be issued.

Guest with Disabilities

Guests will find handicap parking at the Recreation Lodge. Rest room #1 features handicapped toilet facilities and Rest Rooms #2 & #3 offer private handicap toilet and shower facilities. We also have a pool lift accommodations at our swimming pools. Please see an attendant for assistance. If you are disabled and require the use of a golf cart, our insurance company requires a certificate of insurance naming Normandy Farms as additional insured.

Guest Code of Conduct

We are committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable environment so we are presenting a Code of Conduct designed to enhance the experience of all our guests.

Guests are responsible for their conduct and are prohibited from the following:

Exhibiting behavior that is unruly, disruptive, irresponsible or illegal in nature, which is a distraction to the enjoyment of other guests.

- Using foul or abusive language or making obscene gestures.
- Interfering with the enjoyment of others, an event or activity.
- Engaging in public drunkenness.
- Not following Normandy Farms Campground guidelines or directives.
- Verbally or physically harassing any of our guests or Team Members.
- Engaging in any solicitation.
- Failing to follow campground guidelines including but not limited to adherence to quiet hours and family friendly attire.

Based upon the discretion of Management, Guests who violate these provisions may be ejected from the campground without a refund and may be issued a letter of disinvite, prohibiting future visits to the campground. We thank you for adhering to our Code of Conduct, we hope this directive will enhance the camping experience for all guests.

If you or a member of your camping party is affected by another guest due to a violation of the Code of Conduct, please contact our Reception Center at 866-673-2767 x1 or Hospitality Station if after hours at x312.

Family Friendly Attire

Proper attire, including shoes and shirts, should be worn at all times. The park is a casual, family-oriented environment. Ensuring our resort is family friendly is an important part of the camping experience. In that spirit, we ask you to use your discretion and common sense. Attire that is not appropriate for the park—and which may result in refusal of admittance—includes but is not limited to:

- Clothing with objectionable material, including obscene language or graphics
- Clothing which, by nature, exposes excessive portions of the skin that may be viewed as inappropriate for a family environment
- Offensive tattoos

Drones

For the privacy and safety of our guests, drones are not permitted on our property.

In the event of a weather advisory, we are located in Norfolk County.

FACILITIES & RECREATION

Nature Trails

Scenic Fishing Pond and Picnic Area. Nearby State Forest-great for biking and hiking.

Playgrounds

Little campers will love romping for hours in our two playgrounds, where there's plenty of fun for all ages. Sorry, pets are not permitted in playgrounds. Please observe all playground guidelines.

Horseshoes

Join a tournament or just practice your ringer shots. Head on out to Safari 4 where there are 6 horseshoe pits and let the fun begin!

Shuffleboard

Shuffleboard courts are located on the deck above pool #4. See a Recreation Lodge attendant for equipment. An adult must accompany children.

Disc Golf

Our 18-hole course will challenge your throwing skills and accuracy. You can pick up scorecards, discs, and a map at the Recreation Lodge or Reception Center in the off-season.

Dog Park & Pet Walking

Freedom Tail Park was especially designed for our four legged friends and is located near safari #4. For the health and safety of our dogs and guests, please abide by all the posted rules. Need someone to let your dog out for a break or to take out for a walk while you're out sightseeing? Inquire at the Reception Center about availability for our pet-walking service. Or better yet, allow your dog to hang outside in the comfort of his or her very own custom Canine Coop complete with a dog house. Inquire at the Reception Center for a key (fee applies).

Basketball

Play a full court game on our regulation sized court or just practice your 3-point shots. The court is open from 9am to 10pm. There is also another area for shooting hoops in Safari #4.

Please remember:

- Appropriate footwear must be worn to prevent marking the court surface
- No climbing on fence or basketball posts
- Sorry, no pets on the basketball court
- No bikes, skateboards, scooters, roller skates or blades, street hockey or anything else that could damage the court

Soccer

Our soccer field is in safari #4 next to ball field #2. Check your activity list for the next scheduled game.

Softball

Don't miss out on the excitement of a One Pitch Tourney or join one of our organized games. We have two fields; field #1 is next to the Reception Center and field #2 is in Safari #4.

- Softball only played on fields
- No bikes or pets on or around fields
- No climbing on backstops or equipment buildings

Volleyball

Our sand volleyball court is located in Safari #4. Put together your own team or join our Recreation Staff for an organized game.

Bocce

Similar to lawn bowling, bocce is a competitive game that is perfect for the whole family. Courts are located between sites 813 and 814 and Bocce sets are available at the Recreation Lodge.

Equipment Use

Complimentary use of basketballs, volleyballs, footballs, bocce balls, discs, tennis equipment, soccer balls, shuffleboard, poker chips and cards are available at the Recreation Lodge (or Reception Center in off-season). Sorry, no softball equipment is lent out. Horseshoes are accessible anytime at the Equipment Building in Safari #4. All equipment is available on an hourly basis. There is a fee for lost, stolen, or damaged equipment.

- A participant in a recreation activity is responsible for all of the following:
- Act within the limits of his or her ability.
- Be cautious of all warnings regarding participation in the recreational activity.
- Maintain control of his or her person and the equipment used while participating in the recreational activity.
- Refrain from acting in any manner that may cause or contribute injury to himself or herself or to other persons while participating in the recreational activity.

Any violation constitutes negligence.

Bike Park & Bicycles

Our seasonal bike park features a jump line, pump track and skills area. Please note, that the bike park will be closed if conditions are wet or muddy.

We suggest that children age 16 and under wear a helmet while riding bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller skates or blades and we ask that you observe basic safety precautions:

- Riding is prohibited on or around walkways of any buildings or swimming areas
- No riding on or around ball field areas
- Racing around park is not allowed
- Do not cut through campsites
- Riding after dark is prohibited
- Only one rider on a bike at a time
- Riding is prohibited on the basketball court and the entrance & exit parking areas by the Reception Center

Swimming

While at the pools you may be tempted to sunbathe and relax, or talk with family and friends; however, it is your responsibility to watch your family members and guests and remain alert at all times. We agree that rules can sometimes seem restrictive, but these guidelines are for your safety and protection. A parent or guardian can make all the difference between danger and safety. We would like you to know that Swimming Is At Your Own Risk and that Our Pools Are Not Staffed With Lifeguards! Please note that smoking in pool area is only permitted in designated smoking area.

Pool Standards require that:

- Children under sixteen (16) should not use the pool without an adult in attendance
- Must be 18 or older to use Sauna and Jacuzzi facilities
- Do not swim alone
- Do not leave children unattended, even for just a minute
- Be aware of safety equipment locations in the pool area
- Call 911 for Emergency Help
- If you have questions about the use of our pool facilities, please ask any one of our team members

For your safety:

- No inflated tubes, beach balls, etc. in the pools
- No running, pushing, or horse-play in or around the pool area
- No diving
- Remember to obey all posted rules when using the pool
- No glass or alcoholic beverages in pool area
- Please show courtesy to other swimmers by not leaving your belongings on chairs while not using them

Reception Center, Business Center, Store & Gift Shop

Since Normandy Farms has so much to offer, the best way to learn everything is to begin at the Reception Center. Here, our Guest Service Specialists will check you in, arrange for future reservations and provide you with everything you need to have the most memorable vacation. You'll also find our Store and Gift shop in the same location, where you'll find it all - from soup to nuts and everything in between!

Recreation Lodge

This magnificent 20,000 square foot Lodge is fully air conditioned for your comfort . Our schedule of events is posted in the foyer of the Lodge where you will find a rainy day schedule in the event of inclement weather. The Lodge is the primary location for many of our activities, entertainment events, scheduled breakfasts, and dinners (see activity schedule for details). As you enter the building you will be on the main floor, which features four 80 inch TV's. This is also where the majority of indoor activities are held and is the location of the Activity Room, Arcade, Rest Rooms, vending machines, and change machine. Upstairs in the Adult Loft, you will be spoiled with a cozy fireplace, wide screen TV, pool table, library, and comfy couches to relax. You can enjoy your delicious Kamper's Kitchen lunch or dinner on the spacious deck overlooking the pools and snack bar. On the opposite side of the Adult Loft is the Activities Loft where kids and adults of all ages can watch TV, shoot pool, play games, enjoy reading, or just hang out. Sorry, no food or beverages in this area. Children 5 and under should be accompanied by an adult when visiting the Activities Loft.

Arcade

The Arcade is located on the main level of the Recreation Lodge and features air hockey, pinball machines, and video games for the whole family to enjoy. No food or drink permitted.

Wellness Center

Enjoy a relaxing massage to invigorate the body and mind. Our professionally licensed massage therapists are trained to offer Swedish or deep tissue massages. If you would like to book a massage, please call 866-673-2767 x325

Fitness Center

Located next to the indoor pool on the lower level of the Recreation Lodge, our Fitness Center is fully equipped with various machines and free weights to help you keep in good health. Please abide by all posted rules when using this facility.

Tennis

Play a game of tennis or pickle ball on our tennis court located adjacent to the basketball court.

Laundry Facilities

Self-service laundry facilities, complete with detergent dispensers and change machines, are located at Rest Rooms #1, #2, & #3.

Creative Arts Center

Join us in our Creative Arts Center for a feature movie presentation on our large theatre screen with impeccable surround sound. In addition to movies, we also have Yoga, Arts n' Crafts, Cribbage, and many other activities in this facility, which is located on the lower level of the Recreation Lodge.

Restrooms & Showers

Four full service restroom facilities complete with complimentary hot showers are conveniently located throughout the park and are open 24 hours. Private restroom facilities for people with special needs are also available. Restrooms can also be found in the Recreation Lodge, Pool Areas, and Reception Center.

Business & Information Center

Deciding where to visit while at Normandy Farms can be as difficult as deciding what activity to join in. Stop by the Business & Information Center located in the Reception Center to visit our Concierge who will assist you in making dining reservations and help arrange your day trip outside the park complete with maps, literature, and a smile (seasonal availability). We know that sometimes work must get done even while vacationing, so we offer a full service business center complete with computers, a printer, and free high speed Internet access.

Notary Service

We offer free notary service. Please inquire for availability.

Propane Service

Metered propane filling for motor homes is available daily from 9am to 5pm at the filling station. Individual bottles are filled twice daily at 1pm & 5pm for a flat rate. Inquire at the Reception Center for cost and availability.

ATM

An ATM can be found at the Reception Center.

Internet & Satellite

For those who want to stay connected, we offer complimentary wireless Internet service throughout the entire park. Work from your RV or sit by the pool, either way, you're connected. We also have computer stations fully equipped with free high-speed Internet access available in our Business & Information Center located in the Reception Center. For those traveling with a satellite dish, please keep in mind that we have many trees here in New England, so satellite service may be limited.

Function Rooms

Camping groups may inquire at the Reception Center for use of our function rooms at the Recreation Lodge. Groups are responsible for leaving the facility clean and orderly. A refundable deposit is required. Requests should be made well in advance to ensure availability. Special campground events and rainy day activities have priority.

GETTING AROUND THE NEIGHBORHOOD

Easy Directions Around Town

Heading into Mansfield (about 3 miles from the park) will bring you to a Non-Denominational Church, Supermarket, Bank, Post Office, Pharmacy, Restaurants, Health Center, Coffee Shops, Car Wash & More!

Turn right out of Normandy Farms. Continue 1 mile to end of West Street, (Union Church on right at this intersection) go straight onto North Grove Street. At end of North Grove, take a left onto Route 106.

About 2 miles on left (at first traffic light) is Super Stop & Shop, a full-size grocery store with a Bank, Gas Station, Liquor Store and Dunkin Donuts. Leave store and take left, then a right onto 140. Take your 3rd right onto School Street and take your next left into Mansfield Crossing (www.mansfieldcrossing.com) where you will find Petco, LL Bean, Best Buy and much more! There is also a Bertucci's and Cold Stone Creamery. If you cross over Route 140 after taking a left out of the Stop & Shop parking lot, staying on Route 106, prior to reaching your next light (about 1/2 mi) there is a Post Office, CVS, and Rite Aid Pharmacy. Continuing east on Route 106 to another light, you will find a Honey Dew Donuts, and by turning left onto Central Street and continuing for 1 mile, you will find the Mansfield Health Center on the left. By continuing on Route 106 east at the next light is the Commuter Train Station (on left), Car Care Pro's Car Wash and Fresh Catch Seafood & Suishi Bar thru light on right.

Heading approximately 3 miles north on Route 1 will bring you to Patriot Place (www.patriot-place.com), which features Trader Joe's, Bass Pro Shop, Bed Bath & Beyond, EMS, Brigham & Women's Hospital and MUCH MORE! Additionally, there are many dining options including Davios, CBS Scene, Skipjacks, and the Olive Garden. There is also a Showcase Cinema DeLux and Showcase Live where top acts perform in all music and comedy genres.

Heading south on Route 1 will bring you to Target on your right and Lowes on the left approximately 2 miles down Route 1. Emerald Square Mall, a 3-story mall located on the right side of Route 1 approximately 12 miles from the Park.

Turn left out of Normandy Farms. Continue for 1.5 miles to traffic light. Turn left onto Route 1 - you will be heading South. About 1.5 miles down will bring you to 495 North. Follow 495 North to exit 15 to Wrentham Village Premium Outlets. Exit 17 off 495 North offers a AAA Branch. Or Continue on 495 North to exit 18 (Bellingham) for Whole Foods (Natural Foods), Hoyt's Cinema, Gap, Old Navy, Wal-Mart, McDonald's and Barnes & Noble Bookstores.

OUR STORY

Francis Daniels was born June 22, 1723 in the Province of Normandy, France. While still a young man, he entered the French Army and was assigned to the West Indies where he became an officer. Taken sick, he spent months in the hospital before returning to duty. The move proved premature, as he became ill once again, so he decided to return to France. The ship was captured by a Colonial privateer and brought to Massachusetts Bay Colony in Boston, where the young prisoner was a source of income to the privateers and was imprisoned for three months. George Hewes, keeper of the jail, spoke French, and took a liking to his young charge. He made him aware of his brother in Wrentham, a wealthy landowner in need of hired help. With the promise of being paid wages for his services, young Francis went to Wrentham and lived with the

Hewes family. Francis was indebted for the cost of his passage, and was 36 years old before it was paid off and he was able to purchase property himself. The Suffolk Registry of Deeds shows that on June 6, 1759 "William Hewes of Wrentham deeded to Francis Daniels 53 acres of land for 7 pounds, 18 shillings." The land which Francis purchased and began to farm was to be included in an area, set aside from Wrentham and other towns, to form a new community, called Foxborough. Francis died June 23, 1813 and was buried in the Central Burying Ground, a small cemetery outside the center of Foxborough where Memorial Hall now stands. Years later, when Central St. was widened, his grave was moved to Rockhill Cemetery. His gravestone can now be found on the west hillside, facing the pond. As the years passed, the farm has grown in acreage,

and each succeeding generation has taken its place at Normandy Farms. From dairy to chickens, then raising sheep, the family has worked the land first cleared from the wilderness over 250 years ago. Now, the 7th, 8th, & 9th generations are contributing to New England's finest camping resort, which has been nationally recognized as RV Park of the Year and been featured on the Travel Channel as one of the premier camping destinations in the world.

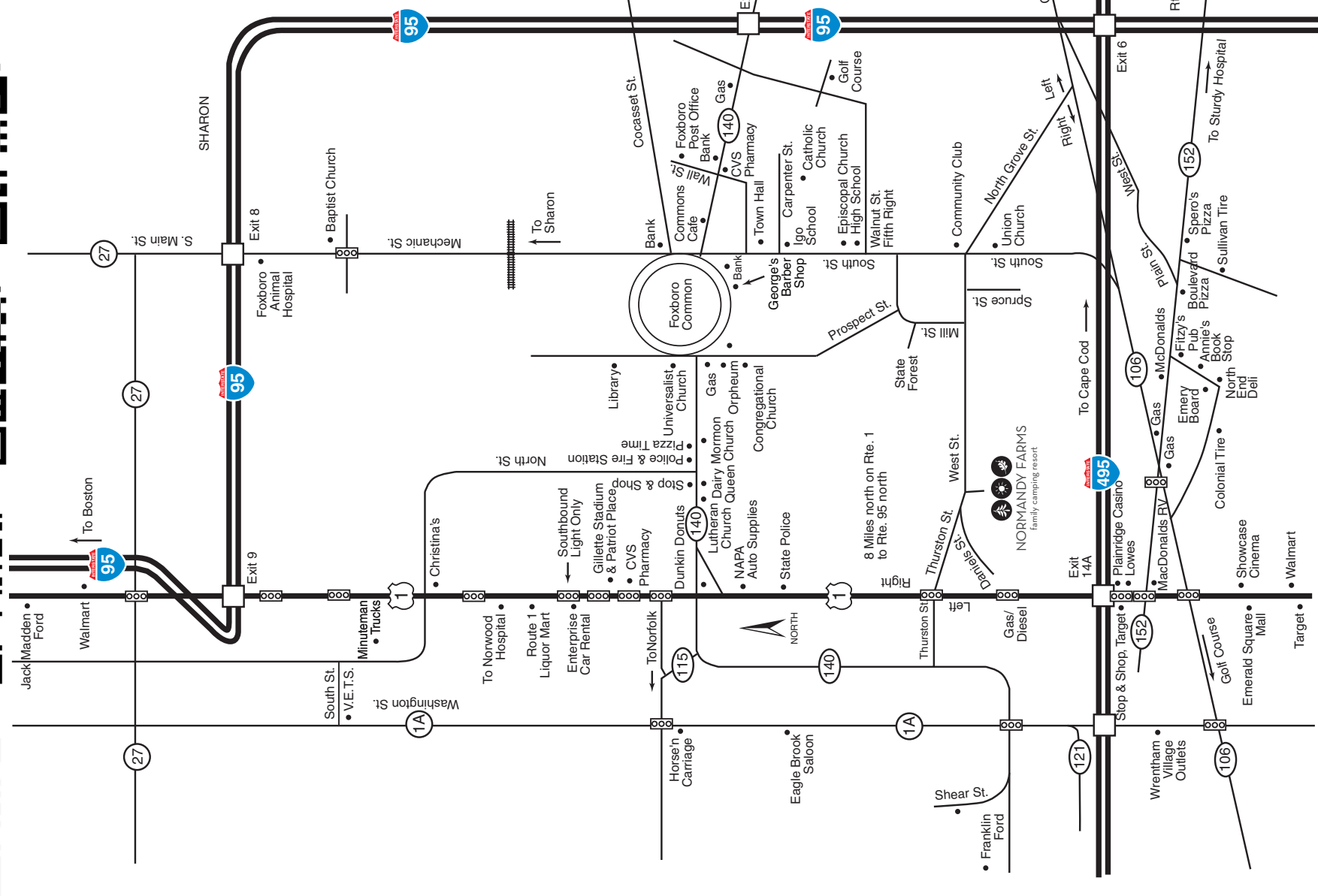
