- Accessible via **MBTA Blue Line (Airport Station)**
- **Free Massport shuttle buses** connect the subway station to all terminals

Silver Line (Direct from South Station)

- **SL1 bus** runs directly to Logan
- Look for airplane symbols
- **Free from airport → city**, standard MBTA fare from South Station

✓ Visitor Tips
